TECHNICAL BULLETIN **APPLICATION STANDARDS ADDITIONS & REVISIONS**

The following application standards changes and additions received ARCA Warranty Ltd. Board approval and are in effect and available for viewing on the website. Changes to the application standards are identified within the on-line manual by dated text boxes shown in the left hand page margin.

PART 2 – LOW-SLOPE ROOFING

Division 1 – Built-up Roofing, Section 5 – Insulation

Asphalt core board with a minimum thickness of 1/8" (3 mm) is an accepted alternative to wood fiberboard as an insulation cover board in asphalt and felt BUR systems. See 5.4 in the manual.

Divisions 1, 2, 3, and 4: Section 8 – Sheet Metal Flashings

A recommendation is included in the manual to address the oil-canning affect of parapet cap flashings (coping) when the vertical leg extension exceeds the minimum dimension. See 8.1.3 in the manual.

PART 3 – STEEP-SLOPE ROOFING

Section 2 – Asphalt Shingle Roofing

IKO/CRC have made a name change to their ARCA approved inorganic laminate shingles, Cambridge and Biltmore.
