TECHNICAL BULLETIN **APPLICATION STANDARDS ADDITIONS & REVISIONS**

The following application standards changes and additions received ARCA Warranty Ltd. Board approval and are in effect and available for viewing on the website. Changes to the application standards are identified within the on-line manual by dated text boxes shown in the left hand page margin.

Hot-asphalt applied Georgia Pacific Densdeck and Densdeck Prime cover boards

Revision in Section 5 – Insulation, Gypsum Roof Boards

Gypsum roof boards may be adhered to accepted substrates with approved adhesive, hot bitumen, or mechanically attached to the roof decking following the membrane manufacturer's written securement requirements. Hot bitumen attachment in a full mopping is permitted only over faced insulations that are not heat sensitive.

Reference to wind uplift requirements

Added to Section 6 – Primary Membrane, Design Considerations

It is recommended that roof assemblies are designed in accordance with National Building Code to meet wind uplift performance. The roof membrane manufacturer shall confirm system application requirements to resist design wind loads for the building location.
